Care Package Items

Travel Sizes Only, No Aerosols, and Nothing That Will Melt

Troops have little storage and must carry 50 lb + in gear.
The smaller the items the better. **THINK CAMPING!**

- Baby Wipes – travel size. **"Hoo Ahhs" brand pre-moistened no scent preferred**
- Lotion – tube only
- Kleenex – individual packets
- Blistex, Vaseline, Carmex – tube only
- Beef Jerky/Slim Jims
- Energy Bars (Power Bar, etc. - **"HOOAH!" brand energy bar preferred**)
- Sunflower seeds
- Peanuts
- Fig Newtons, Oreos, Cheese & Crackers - Small Packs
- Trail Mix, Dried Fruit, Granola, Fruit Roll-Ups / Fruit By The Foot / Fruit Gummies
- Seasoning Salt (Lawry's, etc.)
- Atomic Fireballs / Jolly Rancher hard candy (for service member use)
- Smarties or SweetTart candies (for local children who prefer sour style candy to build relationships with community)
- Powdered drink mix individual packets (Gatorade, Kool-Aid, lemonade, hot chocolate, etc.)
- Chewing Gum
- Avon Skin So Soft - great for removing face paint
- Personal Hygiene Gear: Disposable Razors, Toothbrush and Tooth Paste, Mouthwash
- Eye Wash / Drops (Visine, etc.) for flushing dust and sand out of the eyes
- Tylenol, Motrin, Advil or Aspirin Packets
- Zip-Lock style Plastic Storage Bags - assorted sizes, heavier freezer style are better
- Copenhagen Snuff in a tin – 10 pack log preferred
- AA-cell Alkaline Batteries
- 35 mm disposable cameras
- Stationery, Envelopes, and Pens - blank cards to send home
- Disposable Hand warmers and Foot warmers (in the wintertime)
- Small bibles or devotionals
- Pre-paid Phone Card so service member can call home
