Monthly Cruise Nights hosted by Memory Lane Cruisers are the 1st Saturday of each month at the Kmart / Wendy's parking lot located at the junction of Rte 41A and Rte 76 or MLK Pkway. The Cruise-in starts at 6:00pm, but most MLC arrives early to assist in setting up the activities. In 2009, the monthly cruise night was approved by club members in order that we might visit other club's cruise-in's, etc. However, many MLC members still prefer to gather at the Kmart / Wendy's parking lot each and every Saturday night. And that's OK.

Club activities change every week depending on what is going on in the Middle Tennessee. Some may be traveling long distances to big shows, swap meets, auctions, while others are staying close for one of the local activities. There is always plenty to do. On either Saturday or Sunday, following the business meeting, the club will cruise in their old cars to an eating establishment in the area, (Generally no more than 60 miles), have dinner and then return to the Clarksville area. This is called a Rod Run.
